Project Description:

This project required development of Schematic Design studies for renovations and additions to an existing synagogue. The main focus of the design was to increase the capacity of the existing two-story sanctuary and single story main entrance lobby, which would increase the amount of available seating and pre-function space. Another central design feature was the positioning of new function spaces with exterior patio. The design allows the two function spaces be open to the main sanctuary, thus allowing the sanctuary to be expanded for additional High Holiday sessions.

The temple design also addressed the need to look toward future growth, such as classrooms, library, toiletrrooms, kitchen, catering delivery, administrative and clergy offices.
